



# HOW TO APPLY

- 1 Visit [www.myexplore.ca](http://www.myexplore.ca) and apply for the EXPLORE bursary (Canadians only). See the page to the right for more information.
- 2 Visit [www.usainteanne.ca/french-immersion](http://www.usainteanne.ca/french-immersion) to complete and submit the registration form.
  - If you register online (payment with Visa or Mastercard), your \$275 registration fee reserves your place in the program.
  - If you prefer to pay by money order, please download the registration form and mail it to us, along with your \$275 payment.

We accept VISA, Mastercard, or money orders (made payable to Université Sainte-Anne). If you withdraw at least four weeks before the start of the 4-week or 5-week sessions, \$225 of the \$275 registration fee will be reimbursed to you. Students who leave while the session is in progress will lose the \$275 enrolment fee and will be charged for an extra seven days after their date of departure. Applications are processed on a first-received, first-admitted basis. Receipt of the registration fee reserves your place in the program. Last-minute applications are considered in the event of cancellations.

\* A \$275 enrollment fee is included for all sessions except the 1-week program (which has a \$50 enrolment fee). Students are responsible for paying the enrolment fee, which is not covered by the EXPLORE bursary.

## ACCOMMODATIONS

All students live in residence on campus and eat at the university's cafeteria. A room will be reserved for you in residence upon receipt of your application and deposit. If you wish to arrive a day earlier than specified, you must let us know so we can ensure that your room is available. Students are placed in residence according to their age.

The EXPLORE bursary is available to Canadian citizens and landed immigrants who are in Grade 11 or 12 or enrolled as full-time post-secondary students in the 2019-2020 academic year.

**Travel expenses and the \$275 enrolment fee are not covered by the bursary and must be paid by students.**

Application forms are available online. Applications and all necessary documents must be postmarked no later than **February 15** and mailed to your provincial coordinator.

The program offers bursaries to students wishing to improve their knowledge of French. It covers all tuition fees, room, meals and almost all socio-cultural activities for a 5-week program.

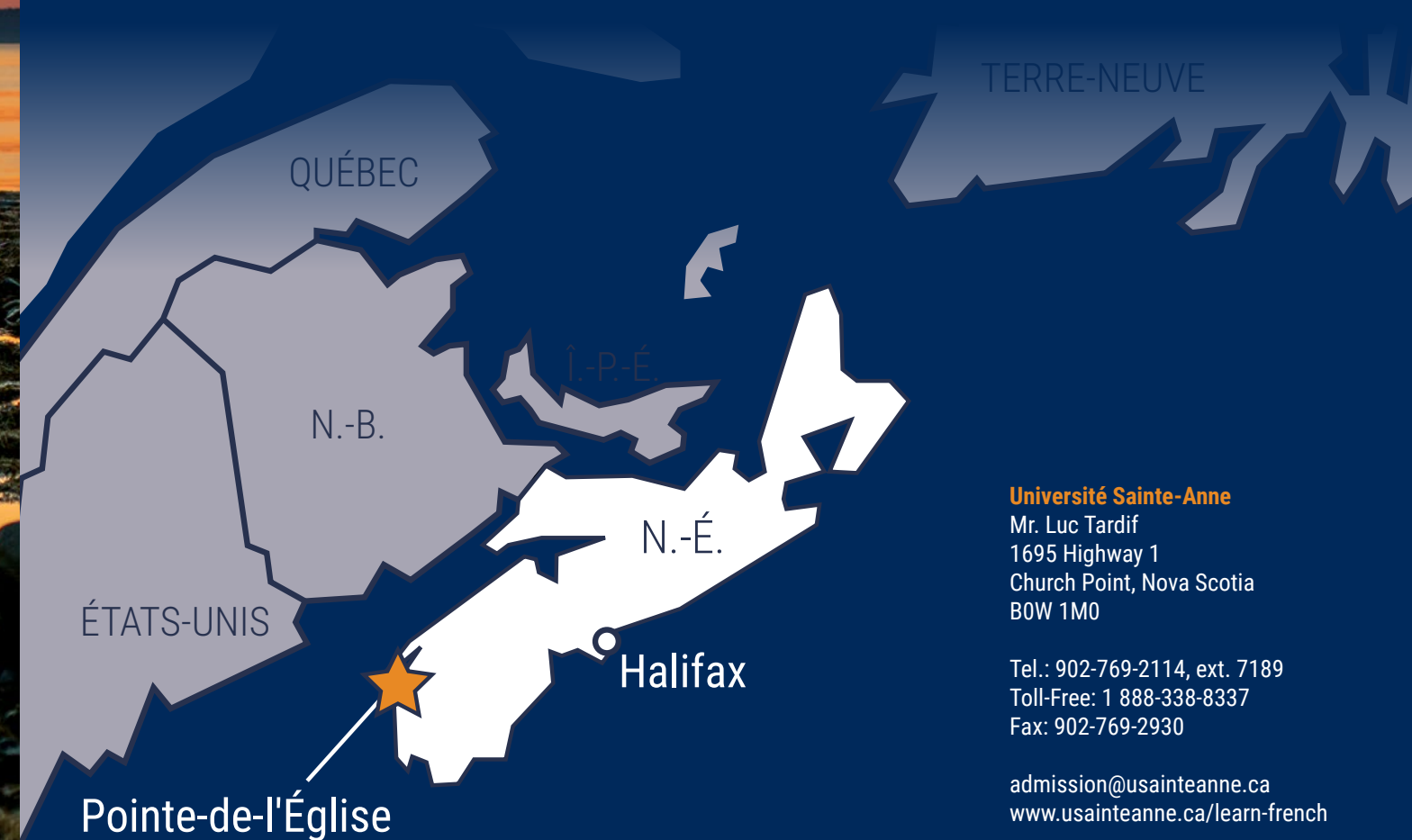

## THE SESSIONS

**5-WEEK SPRING SESSION (MAY 17 to JUNE 20)**  
 University students and adults who wish to perfect their French can benefit from our 5-week French immersion session in the spring. The schedule is very similar to the summer session. Students must be at least 19 years old to enroll.

**5-WEEK SUMMER SESSION (JULY 5 to AUGUST 8)**  
 Students from across Canada, the United States, and overseas come to study and have fun during our summer session. A well-trained, professional staff of teachers and counselors ensures a pleasant learning experience.

Activities range from theme nights, excursions, and whale-watching expeditions to canoeing and golf — all in French, of course! Students attend two formal classes (6 university credits) in the morning, have a workshop in the afternoon, and activities are planned for the remainder of the day and the weekend. There is no time for boredom and fun is guaranteed! Students must be at least 15 years old to enroll. Many adults participate, too, and are housed in separate residences.

**4-WEEK SESSION FOR TEACHERS (JULY 5 to AUGUST 1)**  
 This program is specifically designed for teachers who wish to hone their French, renew their skills as instructors, enrich their supply of pedagogical activities, and immerse themselves in a dynamic French atmosphere.

Students participate in an intensive 4-week period of courses. They are led by a team specifically trained in the latest approaches in the instruction of French. Please check with your provincial government for information about bursaries that may be available.

**1-WEEK PROGRAM (AUGUST 1 to AUGUST 8)**  
 This mini-session is offered on a first-come, first-serve, limited-enrolment basis. Students must be at least 10 years old to attend this session.



**MORNINGS**  
 Students attend two formal classes in spoken and written French.



**AFTERNOONS**  
 Students participate in mandatory workshops. These include outdoor activities, souvenir album, dance, video, blog, music, etc. Following the workshops, sports are organized for each residence.



**EVENINGS**  
 Social activities include bands performing on campus, casino night, open-mic night, "café-théâtre", and even our own escape room!



**WEEKENDS**  
 Look forward to trips to the beach, whale watching, canoeing, trekking, and more! Activities vary based on weather conditions and availability.

**CERTIFICATE**  
 Students who successfully complete the 5-week spring or summer sessions will receive a certificate indicating their completed level of competency in French, and a transcript.

**CREDITS**  
 Students receive credit for one 6-credit university course upon successful completion of each session.

Students may request that credits for successfully-completed courses be transferred to other universities or high schools. Note: acceptance of credit transfers depends on the receiving institution.

## THE PLACEMENT TEST

The placement test is a French-language equivalency evaluation given on the first Monday of every session. Don't worry about studying! The results of the test allow us to place you into one of our 8 program levels according to your skill:

- Beginner 1
- Beginner 2
- Intermediate 1
- Intermediate 2
- Intermediate 3
- Advanced 1
- Advanced 2
- Very Advanced
